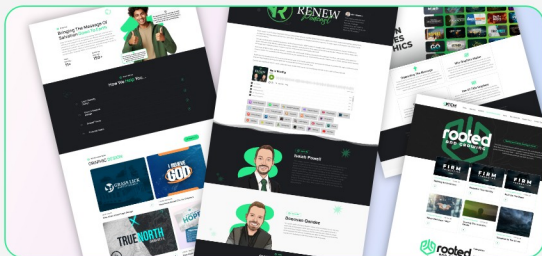

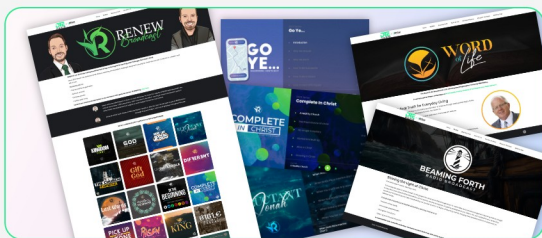


## New Websites

The website *dteradio.com* has become the home for archives and information about radio broadcasts and programs produced by DTEM. We currently have every series ever aired on the Renew Broadcast available to listen to on-demand. Each episode is conveniently separated into a playlist by series. There are currently 20 different series available to listen to.



## Good Design In A Visual World

Whether it is a social media post, a church website, an event flyer, or a sermon graphic on a screen, visuals are frequently the first point of contact between a church and its community. In this kind of environment, clear and thoughtful church graphics have become an important part of communicating ministry effectively. Church graphics are not about style for its own sake, and they are certainly not meant to replace the power of preaching or the truth of God's Word. The gospel itself is the "power of God unto salvation" (Romans 1:16). However, Scripture reminds us, "Let all things be done decently and in order" (1 Corinthians 14:40). When church graphics are clean, readable, and attractive they reflect intentional ministry. They help people quickly understand when an event is taking place, what a sermon series is about, or how they can get involved. In a visual culture, clarity builds trust and encourages engagement.

“Excellence in presentation is not about pride; it is about stewardship. If the gospel deserves our best preaching, it deserves our best designs as well.”

Well-designed graphics can also strengthen outreach. An inviting event graphic or clearly presented announcement may be shared online or passed along to someone searching for hope or direction. What begins as a simple visual invitation can become an opportunity for someone to hear the gospel. The goal is never to impress people with design. The goal is to communicate faithfully and clearly. When churches take care in how they present their message, fewer distractions stand between people and the truth of Christ.

In a visual world, good church graphics are simply another tool that can help the church communicate its mission with clarity, order, and excellence. Good graphics won't make someone read a tract or a flyer, but a poor one may keep them from being interested in what it has to say. That is our approach.

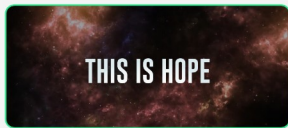
ROOTED IN HIS WORD, GROWING IN CHRIST

## Daily Growth

Faithfulness in the Christian life is rarely built in the dramatic moments we often imagine, but in the quiet, daily choices to trust and follow the Lord. Scripture reminds us that growth is often gradual, like a tree slowly strengthening its roots beneath the soil. The psalmist describes the blessed man as one who delights in the law of the Lord, saying, “*And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season*” (Psalm 1:3). A tree does not grow strong overnight, but through steady nourishment and deepening roots. In the same way, believers are strengthened as they consistently spend time in God’s Word, walk in obedience, and rely on the Lord’s guidance day by day. Even when progress feels slow, God is faithfully at work, shaping our hearts and establishing our faith. That is why Paul encouraged believers to continue “*Rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the faith*” (Colossians 2:7). The Christian life is not about quick spiritual bursts, but about steady devotion to Christ. When our roots go deep into the truth of God’s Word, our lives can stand firm even when the storms and trials of life come our way.
